

Why is it called Zou-no-Hana (elephant trunk)?...When the Port of Yokohama was opened in 1859, two linear quays, the East quay and the West quay, were made. In 1867, the East quay was remade into an elephant-trunk-like curved shape, which eventually came to be called "Zou-no-Hana".


