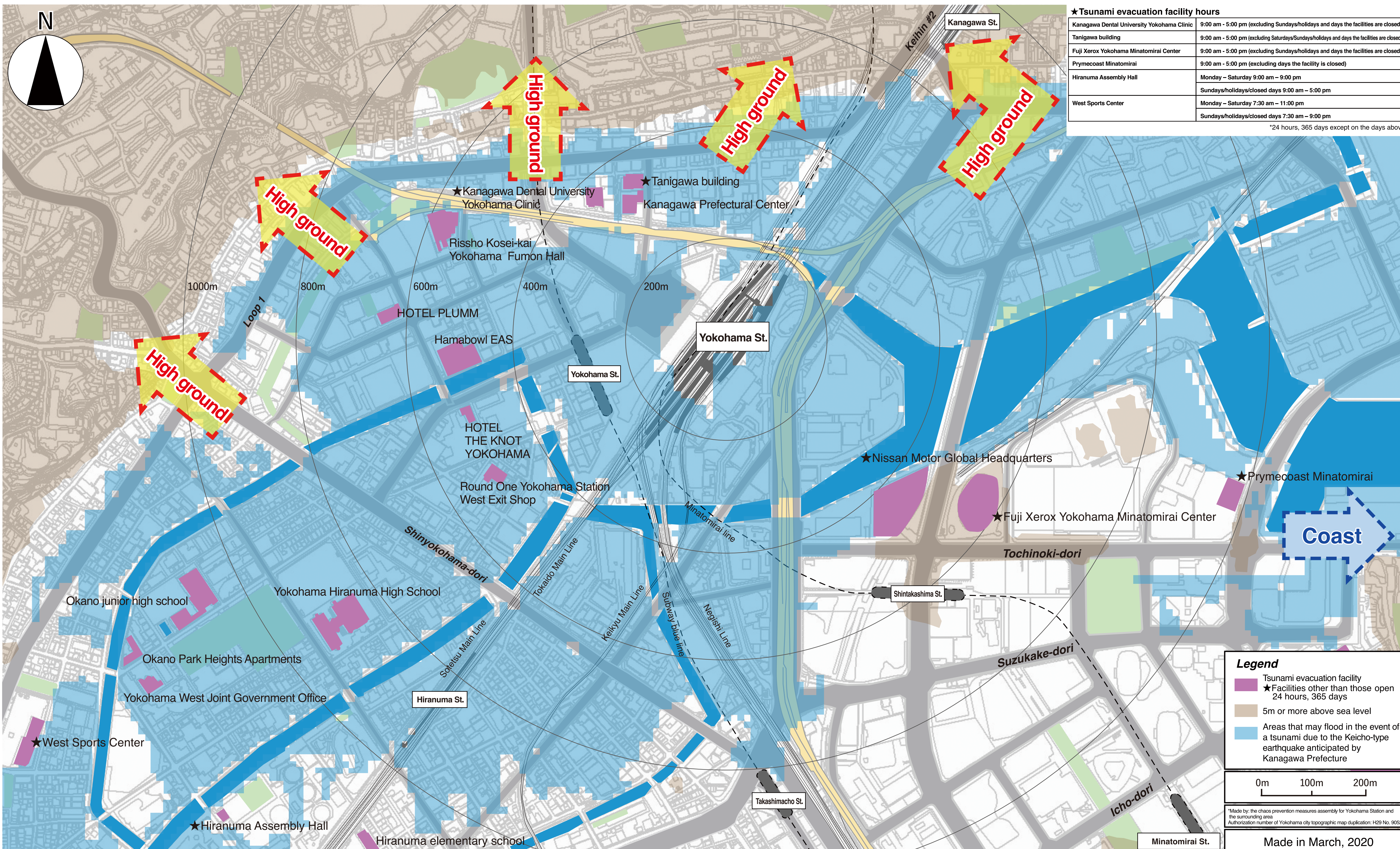




~ Evacuate quicker and higher! ~

This map shows where to evacuate to remain safe when a tsunami warning is issued.

- Evacuate immediately if you feel major shaking due to an earthquake or receive a warning notification for a tsunami etc.
- Evacuate to an area at least 5 meters above sea level, a tsunami evacuation facility, or the highest floor of a reinforced concrete building or other sturdy building with at least 3 floors.
(A tsunami evacuation facility is a building designated as a place of refuge when a tsunami warning is issued.)



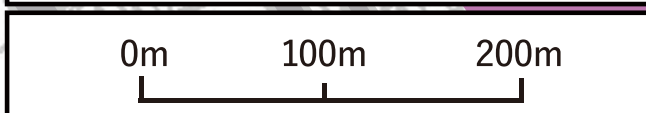

Tanigawa building	9:00 am - 5:00 pm (excluding Saturdays/Sundays/holidays and days the facilities are closed)
Fuji Xerox Yokohama Minatomirai Center	9:00 am - 5:00 pm (excluding Sundays/holidays and days the facilities are closed)
Prymecoast Minatomirai	9:00 am - 5:00 pm (excluding days the facility is closed)
Hiranuma Assembly Hall	Monday - Saturday 9:00 am - 9:00 pm Sundays/holidays/closed days 9:00 am - 5:00 pm
West Sports Center	Monday - Saturday 7:30 am - 11:00 pm Sundays/holidays/closed days 7:30 am - 9:00 pm

*24 hours, 365 days except on the days above
