Both residents and businesses alike are required by city ordinance to separate and dispose of waste according to established categories and methods.

Starting May 1, 2008, all residents and businesses who fail to observe these rules despite repeated instruction otherwise may be subject to fines (administrative fine of JPY2000). Instruction is conducted according to the following steps.

City employees may open and examine garbage bags that contain unseparated garbage.
