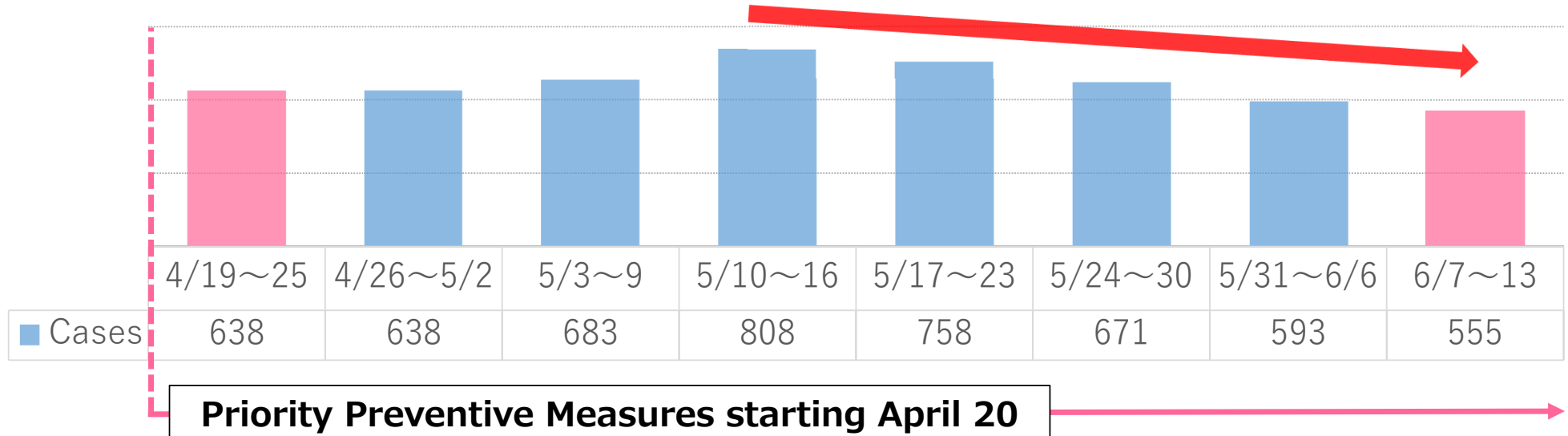


# Infections in Yokohama

**【Stage III】** cases: growing quickly /health care system: some disruptions

**【Stage IV】** cases: explosive growth/health care system: severe disruption

◇ **Variant cases in Kanagawa ≈83%** (May 31 - June 6)

※ Of 1,438 new cases, 579 variant infections identified from 697 variant tests in Kanagawa Prefecture.

## Individual vaccinations for elderly residents

- **Individual vaccinations at local health care facilities to soon start in earnest**
- **Nearly 1,500 locations** providing vaccinations in the city currently

## Individual vaccinations for elderly residents

- **First, consult your primary care doctor**
- **Around 870 locations provide vaccinations to non-regular patients**

## Future priority vaccinations

- **Priority vaccinations to start in July** once elderly residents are vaccinated

### [Eligible priority recipients]

- Those with **underlying conditions**
- **Workers at long term care facilities**

## Vaccine vouchers to residents 64 and younger

- Sent out: **late June and July**
- Eligible recipients: between 12 and 64 years old
  - ✘ Distributed in 5-6 waves based on age groups (about 1-week intervals)
- Notices will be sent to **non-priority vaccine recipients at a later date**
