

# Extension of priority preventive measures for Kanagawa and Yokohama

## [Kanagawa Prefecture]

- Restaurants, pubs, etc.: **to close by 8 p.m. (no change)**

Serving of alcohol: all-day suspension ⇒ **until 7 p.m. \***

\*for establishments under certain conditions: “stay of up to 90 minutes,” “max. 4 people per group,” etc.

## [Yokohama]

- Public facilities: **closed by 8 p.m. (no change)**

Events: **to end by 9 p.m. (no change)**

- City events or co-organized events: **max 5,000 people (no change)**

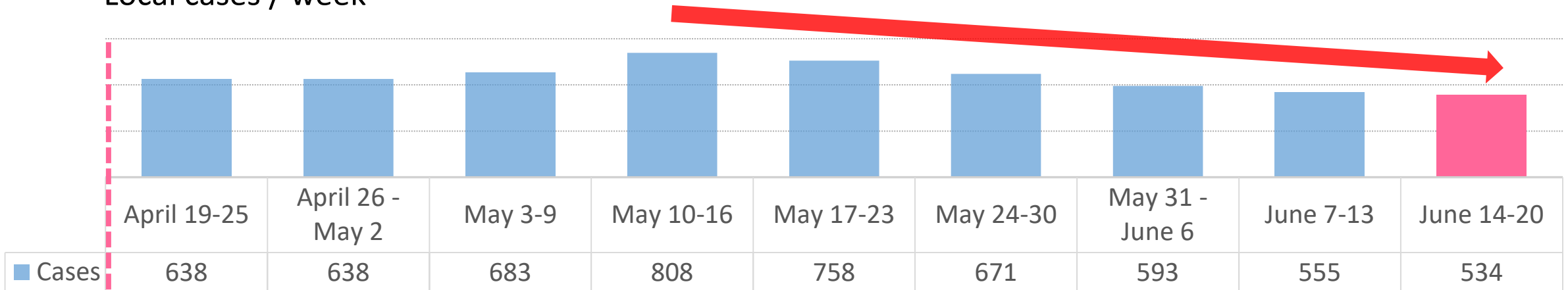
# Infections in Yokohama

## ◆ 534 new cases last week (June 14-20)

**Not a significant change compared to last week**

- **Slowly decreasing since mid-May**

# Schedule of vaccine vouchers to residents 12-64

Age group	Planned send date	Eligible residents
60~64	June 23 (Wed)	≈210,000
50~59	June 30 (Wed)	≈590,000
40~49	July 7 (Wed)	≈560,000
30~39	July 13 (Tues)	≈440,000
20~29	July 19 (Mon)	≈410,000
12~19	July 26 (Mon)	≈240,000

\*It is expected that it will take several days to reach residents after notices are sent out.

\*Only residents 12 and older can get the vaccine. Individual notices will be sent out once residents reach 12 years of age.

# Priority vaccinations

- **Priority vaccination appointments** to open **July 5**

## [Priority vaccine recipients]

- **Persons with underlying conditions**
  - **Workers at long term care facilities, etc.**
- **Non-priority residents** will be sent separate notices about when they can get vaccinated **starting in August**
