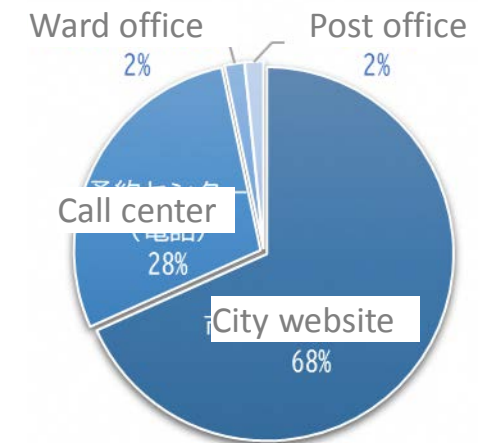

① Booster shot reservation status

- In addition to the dedicated city website, appointments can be made by phone via the call center or at ward offices and post offices. Although the call center may be congested at times, in general the process is smooth.
- Residents can check availability at health care facilities and mass vaccination venues on the city website.
- Appointments can be made as soon as the voucher arrives. We recommend making appointments early.

Appointments can be made without a voucher.

(If 6 months have passed since the 2nd shot)

(1) Eligible residents

City residents who wish to get a booster vaccination and are faculty or staff at city schools or childcare facility personnel

① Municipal school faculty (≈24,000 who are Yokohama residents)

Elementary schools, junior high schools, high schools, special support schools, etc.

- #### ② Childcare facility personnel (≈ 40,000 who are Yokohama residents)
- Nursery schools, kindergartens, accredited childcare centers, community-based childcare centers, temporary care services, childcare services for sick children, unlicensed childcare facilities, daycare facilities for children with disabilities, after-school children's clubs, after-school daycare services, facilities and businesses related to social childcare such as children's homes, etc.

Yokohama is preparing a system to provide children's vaccinations based on an administrative notice (dated January 27) from the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare (MHLW) issued to all local governments to prepare such a system.

*A national subcommittee is expected to determine the exact form this measure for children's vaccinations will take under the Immunization Act.

③ Plans for children's vaccinations

2 When individual notices (with vouchers) will be sent out (eligibility, schedule)

(1) Vaccine vouchers planned to be sent out:

March 4, 2022 (Fri)



- ❖ All vouchers sent out for children turning 5 to 11 years old in 2022 (≈210,000)
- ❖ Starting April 2022, vouchers will be sent for children turning 5 by the end of the month before their birthday
- ❖ Vouchers will be sent by mail, so it may take up to a week before arriving.

③ Plans for children's vaccinations

(2) Priority vaccination period

(Children with underlying conditions eligible)

From when the individual notice is received until March 18 (Fri)

- ❖ Appointments can be made for children with underlying conditions using the included voucher as soon as the individual notice arrives
- ❖ Appointments for children without underlying conditions will be available starting March 19 (Saturday), in order of age groups

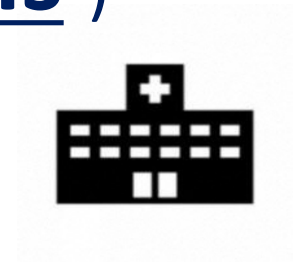

3 Vaccination venues

Individual vaccinations primarily at

4 Appointment method

Appointments made directly with each facility

- ❖ Appointments for certain facilities can be made via the city's dedicated website or by phone via the call center.
- ❖ Supplies of vaccine will be limited at first, so children with underlying conditions will be prioritized. Starting March 19 (Sat), appointments can be made for children in order of age group.

③ Plans for children's vaccinations

5 Schedule

Date	Event
March 4 (Fri)	Vouchers sent out *expected to arrive March 7 or later
Starting March 7 (Mon)	Vaccinations at some health care facilities *Vaccinations to start at facilities with supply of vaccine
Once the voucher arrives until March 17 (Fri)	Priority vaccinations: children with underlying conditions (age 5-11) *Vaccinations available as soon as voucher arrives for children with underlying conditions
Starting March 19 (Sat)	Appointments open for children ages 10-11
Starting March 26 (Sat)	Appointments open for children ages 7-9
Starting April 1 (Fri)	Appointments open for children ages 5-6

6 Information on children's vaccinations

Children's vaccinations require the consent of their parental or guardian, and they will be given guidance on the benefits and potential risks before being asked to confirm their consent on the day of the vaccination.

Also, information about the efficacy and potential side reactions will be listed on the city website.
