1. Charges for Fumigation with Hydrocyanic Acid Gas

(2) Miscellaneous Charges

- (a) The basic rates do not include the cost of chemicals.
- (b) In case of handling hydrocyanic acid gas cylinder, charge for transportation is required separately, because it's considered in the same way as handling high-pressure gas.
- (c) The cost of chemicals shall be estimated in each case as all chemicals are imported.
- (d) Charge for boats standing by alongside the ship for liaison and watch purposes are payable by the ship's owner.
- (e) The following revenue stamps are needed for quarantine. In case of a quarantine officer making a special travel for inspection, traveling expenses and per diem shall be charged in addition to the basic rates

(3) Additional Charges

- (a) Additional charges for special vessels (tankers, ore carriers, fishing factory ships, refrigerated carries, passenger ships, training ships, partial fumigation ships, etc.) are 50 to 100% of the basic rate.
- (b) For work that involves travel and lodging, an additional charge equivalent to 30 to 50% of the basic rate is collected in addition to the traveling expenses, per diem, lodging allowance and the actual cost of transport. For work involving travel that does not require lodging, an additional charge equivalent to 20% of the basic rate is collected.
- (c) Additional charges for work in rough weather or rain are the equivalent of 50% of the basic rate, and work in winter additional charges shall be collected by area.
- (d) Additional charge for work performed on Sundays and holidays are the equivalent of 50% of the basic rate. For half-night and all-night work, additional charges equivalent to 50% to 120% of the basic rate are collected according to the degree of work.

(4) Other Charges

- (a) Waiting charges

In case of delay in starting work due to circumstances on the part of the ship, the following waiting charge shall be collected : ¥10,000 per gang per hour.

- (b) Cancellation charge

In case an order for work is cancelled after arrangements for the work have been completed, a cancellation charge equivalent to 30% of the basic rate shall be collected.

- (c) In case arrangements made have been cancelled, or the appointed day of work has been changed while waiting for work for reasons of weather, etc., a cancellation charge of ¥30,000 per gang shall be collected.

Remarks :

- ① In case additional charges overlap, each additional charge shall be calculated by multiplying the basic rate of additional charge and add together the amounts thus calculated.
- ② Separate estimates will be made for small fishing vessels.

③The half-night hours are from 17:00 to 21:00 hours and all-night hours are from 21:00 to 05:00 hours of the following day.

④The number of waiting hours is calculated on the basis of a delay in the appointed time of boarding the ship or of starting using the chemical.

- (b) Actual expenses shall be separately charged for boats or other transportation costs for round trips to/from vessels by quarantine officers as well as for persons for conducting preparatory inspections/ preliminary discussions.
- (c) Where the acquirement of certificates involves difficulty or where the work is of a time-labor consuming nature, additional charges shall be separately applied depending on the degree involved.
- (d) When rodent-repellent work is conducted, work charges shall be applied as per separately specified rodent repellent charge rates.
- (e) When other work (cockroach repellent etc.) and/or products (rat poisons, insecticides, etc.) are required in preparation for receiving a sanitary inspection, additional charges separately specified shall be applied.

(3) Other additional charges

- (a) For work that requires trips by persons, additional charges in excess of 30% above the basic rates shall be applied, besides the actual travel/boarding expenses and per diem.
 - (b) For work conducted on Sundays and holidays or on Saturday afternoons, charges in excess of 50% above the basic rates shall be applied.
 - (c) For work on mother ship for fishing fleets, passenger ships, training ships, and other designated vessels, additional charges in excess of 50% above the basic rates shall be applied.
- Remark: For work required on small fishing boats, charge estimations shall be conducted separately.

3. Charge Rates for Cockroach-repellent Work in Living Quarters

Note: Cost of insecticide is included in the above rates.

(2) Applicable Items

- (a) For repelling noxious insects other than cockroaches (grain borers, rice weevils, bedbugs, etc.), the cost shall be separately estimated.
- (b) The charge rates above are applicable to the standard work of insecticide (organic phosphorus) spraying. When other special insecticides (coating agents, pyresloid-type vermicides, fumigating agents, etc.) are to be used, the cost shall be separately estimated.
- (c) For partial limited-area repelling work, charges in excess of 70% above the basic rates shall be applied.
- (d) Cost of transportation of equipment, vermicides and the like shall be charged separately.

(3) Other Additional Charges

- (a) For work on passenger ships, ferry boats, mother ships for fishing fleets, training ships, and other designated vessels, additional charges in excess of 70% above the basic rates shall be applied.
- (b) For work on Sundays and holidays, or for half-night work, additional charges of 30% above the basic rates shall be applied. As for all-night work, 80% above the basic rates is applicable.
- (c) For work that requires trips of persons, additional 20% to 30% of the basic rate shall be charged in addition to the actual travel/boarding expenses, per diem, and equipment transportation expenses.

Remark: In the above-listed rates, commuting boat fees are not included.

4. Charge Rates for Insects-repellant work in Cargo Holds

Note: Cost of insecticide is not included in the above rates.

(2) Applicable items

- (a) The above rates are applicable to standard work of insecticide (organic phosphorus) spraying. When the use of other special insecticides (coating agents, pyresloid-type vermicides, smoking-type vermicides, gas fumigating agents, etc.) is requested, the cost shall be separately estimated.
- (b) When partial limited areas in cargo holds are to be subjected to repellent work, the minimum charge of ¥55,000 shall be applied.
- (c) Cost of transportation of equipment, vermicides and the like shall be charged separately.

(3) Additional Charges

- (a) For work on Sundays and holidays, or for half-night work, additional charges of 50% above the basic rates shall be applied. As for all-night work, 120% above the basic rates is applicable.
- (b) For work that requires trips of persons, travel/boarding expenses, per diem, and equipment transportation expenses shall be charged in addition to applying additional charges of 20~30% above the basic rates.

Remarks:

- ① In the above-listed rates, the commuting boat fees are not included.
- ② When work in a cargo hold extends for two days or more, the cost shall be separately estimated.

(2) Associated conditions and additional charges

- (a) In the above-listed charge rates, the cost of rat poisons or catching devices is not included.
- (b) For the work that requires trips of persons, actual travel/boarding expenses and per diem shall be charged in addition to applying additional charges of 20~30% above the basic rates.
- (c) When the commuting boats are used for the work, actual expenses shall be charged.

6. Charges for Examining of Drinking Water
