② Subsidy Requirements/Subsidy Contents

• If a company in the fields of child-rearing, mobility, and decarbonization locates in Yokohama for the first time

This subsidy program is for **non-Yokohama companies** (*1) establishing **offices** (*2) in Yokohama for the first time.

[Subsidy amount] Total of 1 and 2 shown below Up to 5.0 million yen

- 1 Basic amount 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area (Up to 2.5 million yen)
- ②Additional amount 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area (Up to 2.5 million yen)

<Special cases for service offices(*3)>

[Subsidy amount] Total of 1 and 2 shown below Up to 2.5 million yen

- 1) Basic amount 100,000 yen per 10 m² floor area (Up to 1.25 million yen)

This subsidy program is for **non-Yokohama companies** (*1) establishing **offices** (*2) in Yokohama for the first time.

[Subsidy amount] 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area (Up to 2.5 million yen)

<Special cases for service offices(*3)>

[Subsidy amount] 100,000 yen per 10 m² floor area (Up to 1.25 million yen)

[Floor area/personnel] Floor area (*4) in their new location in Yokohama or number of employees (*5) must fit the requirements shown in the system outline (p.1)

[Function of facilities]: Offices (*2)

 If a company in the fields of child-rearing, mobility, and decarbonization expands within Yokohama (Expansion/Relocation Special Cases)

This subsidy program is for companies which have **offices** (*2) in Yokohama and are expanding existing functions/establishing new facilities.

[Subsidy amount] Total of 1 and 2 shown below Up to 2.5 million yen

- 1 Basic amount 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area (Up to 1.25 million yen)
- ②Additional amount 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area (Up to 1.25 million yen)

[Floor area/personnel] Floor area (*4) in their new location in Yokohama or number of employees (*5), must fit the requirements shown in the system outline (p.1).

[Function of facilities] Head office, R&D center, or childcare-related facility (limited to the child-rearing field).

 If a company in other growth fields expands its R&D facilities in Yokohama (Expansion/Relocation Special Cases)

This subsidy program is for companies which have **offices** (*2) in Yokohama and are expanding existing functions/establishing new facilities.

[Subsidy amount] 500,000 yen per 50m² floor area Up to 1.25 million yen

[Floor area/personnel] Floor area (*4) in their new location in Yokohama or number of employees (*5) must fit the requirements shown in the system outline (p.1)

[Function of facilities] R&D center


Special Cases for Locations Outside City Center or Foreign Companies

When expanding into districts outside of the specific **city center areas**(*6) pictured below, or **first investment by foreign-affiliated companies**(*7), only one of the two requirements of floor area and personnel shown in the Program Overview (p.1) need to be fulfilled.

E.g. The requirement "At least 50m² floor area and at least 3 employees" would become "At least 50m² floor area or at least 3 employees."









- (*1) Non-Yokohama Companies: This refers to companies (public companies, limited partnerships, unlimited partnerships, limited liability company or Japanese branches of foreign companies (excluding representative offices)) that have not established a R&D Center, head office, branch, place of business, or other similar facility in Yokohama.
- (*2) Offices: This refers to R&D Centers, head offices, offices, childcare-related facilities (limited to the child-rearing field) and other similar facilities which are used for the business. (Factories, warehouses, stores (excluding childcare-related facilities), etc. are not included.)
- (*3) Special cases for service offices: Applicable when a company moves into a service office based on a contract for two years or more which includes additional services related to the use of the office. It is also a requirement that the service office can be registered as a corporation and that it generally recruits tenants.
- (*4) Floor Area: This refers to sections in offices other than storehouses used to store goods, display spaces/showrooms, shops that provide services or sell products (excluding childcare-related facilities), and food/drink facilities.
 - In special cases for service offices: This refers to a separate or partitioned space that can be locked in service offices, etc.
- (*5) Employee count: This refers to workers eligible to receive employment insurance.
- (*6) City Center Areas: This refers to Minato Mirai 21 district, Yokohama Station district, Kannai district, and central Shin-Yokohama district.
- (*7) First Investment by Foreign-Affiliated Companies: This refers to when the investment is from a foreign-affiliated company that does not yet have a place of business in Japan.

3 Business Plan Summary Submission (Prior to Closing of Lease Contract*)

Note that subsidy cannot be applied for if the necessary documentation has not been submitted at least one day prior to closing of lease contract*.

*In the special case of a service office, the contract refers to one which includes additional services related to the use of the office, and in other cases it refers to the lease contract for the building.

[Following submission of form 1]

- Contact our staff after closing your lease contract.
- •When applying for an expansion/relocation special case: before relocating, please obtain "Applicable Establishment Ledger Header 1" from the Hello Work office to which your area is assigned. This document will be required at the time of application in order to confirm the number of employees. (After the relocation, you will be required to submit the "Applicable Establishment Ledger Header 1" again to prove the number of employees after the start of the business.)

4 Application for Subsidies (After the start of the business)

The following documents, including the grant application form, must be submitted after the start of the business.

*After the start of the business, the staff member in charge will conduct an on-site inspection of the business site, etc.

The main documents to be submitted are as follows.

- ·Grant application document and report of actual results (City of Yokohama form)
- •Financial statements (the last 2 fiscal years): Balance Sheet, Income Statement and Breakdown of Selling, General and Administrative Expenses

(Note) If the financial statements for the last 2 fiscal years cannot be confirmed, or if the company has been insolvent for 2 consecutive fiscal years, the company will not be eligible for the grant.

·List of names of executives, etc. (City of Yokohama form): Names, dates of birth, genders, and addresses of all executives

(Note) We will inquire with the Kanagawa Prefectural Police as to whether or not the company may be considered a crime syndicate.

- •Documents to prove the number of employees at the office, etc.: Applicable Establishment Ledger Header 1
- ·A copy of the notification of incorporation/establishment of a corporation or similar document
- ·A copy of the lease agreement (In case of a special cases for service offices, a copy of the service agreement)

5 Procedural Flow and Schedule

The procedures and schedule up until the granting of the subsidy are roughly as follows.

(1) Submission of "Business Plan Summary" (Form 1): By January 2024

(At least one day prior to day of closing lease contract)

(2) On-site inspection of business sites, etc. by our staff: April 2023-January 2024(Following Business start)

(3) Subsidy Application:

April 2023-January 2024 (Following Business start)

(4) Authorization, Notification of Subsidy Issuance/Subsidy Amount Issued: February 2024

(5) Submission of "Subsidy Invoice":



6 Notes (Be sure to read this)

(1) Obligation to continue operation (2 years) and report on the implementation status

- ① During the period of obligation for continuing operation, the business must continue to operate at the business site where the company has established itself.
 - *Period of obligation to continue operation: From the starting date until the day on which two years have passed.
 - *Starting date: The date when the requirements (p.1-2) are met at the relevant business site, etc., and operations related to the business plan summary have started
- ② During the period of obligation to continue operation, the status of operation shall be reported annually in the month containing the stating date by submitting following documents.
 - Status Report (Form No. 10)
 - List of names of executives (Form No. 5)
 - Most recent tax return for corporate citizens' tax (copy)

(Note) If these obligations are violated, the grant decision will be cancelled and the grant money must be returned.

XA 10.95% annual surcharge will be added to the grant to be returned.

(2) Calculation of subsidy amount

If the total amount in the application exceeds the budgeted amount, the amount of the grant will be proportionally divided within the budgeted amount, and the amount applied for will be reduced.

(3) Cannot be used in conjunction with other programs

If the applicant has applied for any of the following, application for this grant (submission of a business plan summary) will not be permitted.
