A Program You Can Enjoy Anytime During the Period

A wide variety of digital content will be projected on the stage at Minato Mirai21's Shinko Central Plaza, including video imagery derived from Yokohama's history, artistic geometrical patterns, and even video imagery that changes in response to people's movements. There will be something to delight everyone, from children to adults.

There will also be illuminations in the plaza's planted areas, including flower illuminations in the shape of roses and color lighting for the plaza trees.

10-Minute Special Productions

During the course of NIGHT SYNC YOKOHAMA there will be dynamic special productions of light and music using color illumination of building walls, searchlight and more, all synchronized between Shinko Central Plaza and eight nearby facilities and lasting approximately 10 minutes each at 18:00, 19:00, 20:00 and 21:00. This never before attempted experimental performance will simultaneously control lights set up at multiple buildings to make the whole district its stage.

In addition, during these 10-minute special productions we will deploy Web AR (augmented reality) technology to allow visitors to overlay digital imagery on top of the actual images captured by their smartphone cameras. Visitors can enjoy an interactive experience by creating their own personalized "productions" of the








