I am delighted that all of you were able to welcome in this new year.

This year the curtain rises at last on the 2020 Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games, and the competitions in baseball, softball, and soccer will be held right here in Yokohama. With the city designated as both as the pre-Olympic camp city for the United Kingdom national team and as the host town for eight different countries as well, we will be holding international exchange activities and programs that, together with Yokohama Triennale 2020 and other major events, will broadcast the boundless appeal of Yokohama to the world.

At the same time, we will continue to work throughout the year on achieving our post-2020 goals. This year the Minato-Mirai 21 district will see the opening of Pacifico Yokohama North, new hotels, and music halls, further driving the district's energy and dynamism. During this year's extended spring holidays we will have six cruise ships in port at the same time, a first time ever for Japan that is sure to further energize our night-time economy. In March we open the Yokohama Ring Expressway North-West Line, and will continue urban development plans with an eye toward bringing the International Horticultural Exposition to the city in 2027. We will also be pouring energy into supporting our small and medium-sized enterprises, revitalizing our shopping districts, and generating new businesses as we take yet another leap forward as Innovation City Yokohama. In June the new Yokohama City Hall building opens its doors for business. We will push forward with urban development in the Kannai and Kangai districts, including finding new ways to utilize the area where the current city hall is standing.

This year we will also be pursuing our study and analysis on attracting IR (integrated resorts) to Yokohama to further spur our city's growth and development, all the while continuing to support a safe and reassuring life for all our citizens. In addition, we will continue with our preparations for the construction of a new Yokohama theater that will become a new center for the transmission of high-quality culture and the arts, further adding to our city's vitality.

We will also be pushing ahead with our ongoing efforts in disaster prevention and mitigation, support for child-rearing, enhancing education and welfare, building a healthier citizenry, and promoting multiculturalism. In short, we will continue to make every effort possible in the year 2020 to bring about a society where anyone and everyone can work and flourish in ways that are right for them as we continue our work to achieve sustainable growth and development for Yokohama.

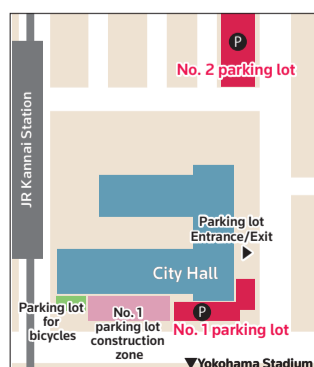

## Fees for Family Registries, Residence Certificates, and Tax Certificates to be Payable with Electronic Money

Effective January 29, 2020, windows for issuing copies of family registries, residence certificates, and tax certificates at administrative service corners and the service windows at ward offices will introduce dedicated electronic payment terminals. Using the terminals, it will now be possible to pay for services using designated electronic money (Suica, PASMO, Rakuten Edy, WAON, and nanaco), as well as in cash.

As with the prior service window payment system using revenue stamps, sales of which will be terminated effective January 28, 2020, going forward please present proof-of-payment seals issued by the electronic payment terminals (good for day of purchase only) to service window staff.

## For Residents Who Suffered Damage to the Roof, Walls or Other Structures of Their Home Due to Typhoon 15 or Other Disasters Guide to Support System for Home Repairs

**[Eligible persons]** Individuals to whom all of the following apply:

- ① Owners of housing who have been issued a disaster damage certificate (*risai shomei sho*) confirming that their housing has been largely or partially destroyed
- ② Individuals with insufficient financial resource to repair their housing by themselves

**[Construction work covered]** Work to which all of the following apply

- ① Construction work begun after September 9, 2019 (work that has already been completed is also covered)
- ② Regarding damaged roofs or outer walls, repair work that contributes to the structure's seismic and other resilience
- ③ The cost (tax included) of the repairs subject to support comes to ¥100,000 (tax included) or more.

**[Amount]** 20% of the construction cost qualifying for support (up to ¥300,000)

**[Application deadline]** Mar. 10 (Tues.), 2020

**[How to apply]**

Obtain an application form from the Housing and Architecture Bureau Housing Measures Division or download from the City of Yokohama homepage, and submit to the Housing Measures Division.

### Regarding the selection of taxation formulas for capital gains and dividend income from listed shares, etc.

In principle, tax filing for "dividend income from listed shares, etc. (excepting payments received by major shareholders, etc.)" and "capital gains from listed shares, etc." in special accounts (withholding selection accounts) is not mandatory. However, if you do choose to file tax returns for these categories, you may use different taxation formulas when filing income tax and when filing inhabitant tax.

When choosing to use different taxation formulas for income tax or inhabitant tax, in addition to your final tax return it is also necessary to submit an individual inhabitant tax filing that states your reason for adopting the different tax formulas and that clearly describes the different tax formulas.

For questions regarding city and prefectural inhabitant tax, please contact the inhabitant tax desk at the Tax Division of the ward office for your ward of residence.

For questions regarding income tax filings, please contact your nearest tax office.

Yokohama is promoting the Yokohama Green-Up Plan to protect, create, and nurture the city's greenery. We are asking our citizens to shoulder the burden of paying the Yokohama Green Tax as one important financial resource for this undertaking. The revenues from the tax provide a reliable guarantee for the city's woodlands and agricultural lands, and is used as well to promote greenification close to home.
