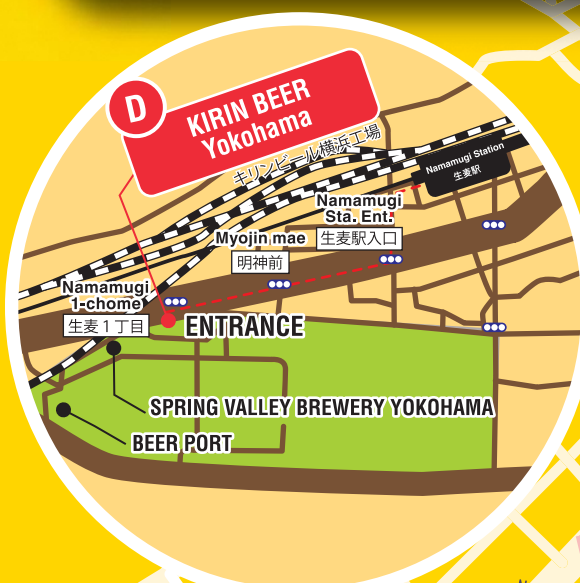


TSURUMI

- One of the main industrial areas in Japan with a variety of people from inside and outside Japan
- Town full of different cultures and food called Okinawa/South America Town because of a large population of people from those areas

1 Tsurumi Shrine



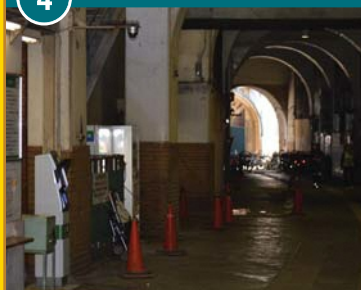
•The oldest shrine in and around Tsurumi built in around 7th century •“Tamatsuri” wishing for a rich harvest and prosperity of descendants is held on every 29th of April. It is the oldest folk performing art in Yokohama since Kamakura era (1185-1333).

2 CIAL Tsurumi Japanese garden



Open: 10:00 - 21:00
• Japanese garden “Seifuuen” and stone garden Zagetsutei” are on the roof of CIAL Tsurumi.
• Shunmyo Masuno, a monk of the Soto Zen temple Kenkohji in Tsurumi and also the prominent garden designer, designed the gardens.

4 JR Tsurumi Line - Kokudo Station



•The station was built in 1930 and is still recognized as the station with the taste of early Showa era (1926 - 1989) by railroad fans.

A Nanamakai



Open: 17:00 - 23:00 (Last Order 22:30), Closed on Sunday
•Okinawa cuisine restaurant
•Okinawa music concert is held irregularly.
•Staffs can speak English (anytime) and Chinese (3 or 4 days a week).

B Zagetsukazuha



Open: 10:00 - 21:00 (Last Order 20:30)
•CIAL Tsurumi 5F (Designed by Shunmyo Masuno) •Zen cafe with tea from Japanese famous tea-growing area, sweets, and food •Lay sermon and small Zen sitting session by a monk is held irregularly.

C Saiwaiya



Open: Weekdays 11:00 - 15:00, 17:30 - 23:00 (Until 21:00 on Sat. and national holidays, Until 15:00 on Sun.), Closed on Monday
•Yokohama’s specialty “Ikei” Tonkotsu (pork bone soup) ramen
•Winner of bronze prize in noodle contest held in Yokohama

3 Daihonzan Sojiji Temple



Guided tour (in Japanese) 10:00h 11:00h 13:00h 14:00h 15:00h

A reservation is needed for guided tour in foreign language. (400 YEN PER PERSON, ABOUT 1 HOUR)

•Head temple of Soto Zen Buddhism with more than 20 buildings
•The temple accepts many visitors from over the world and offers Zazen sitting experience. •International Zen temple with Japanese and non-Japanese monks

5 Namamugi Uogashi Dori



Open: 8:00 - around 10:00, Closed on Sunday, national holidays, Wednesday (not fixed) *Business days and hours vary depending on each shop.
• Seafood market with about 20 shops •The market used to be one of Onsai-hachigaura (8 special areas that used to be designated to provide seafood and vegetables to Edo castle where shogun lived) in Edo era (1603 - 1867).

6 Dounen Inari



•Shrine with 18 lined-up torii gates
•About 300-year-long local festival called “JyamoKamo” festival, deriving from a legend that people in the past contained a plague into a thatch snake doll and threw it to the sea, is held on the morning of the 1st Sunday of June every year.

D Restaurants inside KIRIN BEER Yokohama factory property “BEER PORT” “SPRING VALLEY BREWERY YOKOHAMA”



Open: 11:00 - 22:00, Closed on Monday (open and the following weekday will be closed in case of national holiday), the year-end and New Year holidays *They could be closed temporarily at any time.

•Traditional factory which has taken over the first Japanese beer factory in Yamate, Yokohama •You can enjoy craft beer at “SPRING VALLEY BREWERY YOKOHAMA”, and lamb and other meats’ barbecue at “BEER PORT”. •Brewery tour program was redesigned in 2016 and now it’s enjoyable for adults and kids.
